BY-LAW NO. 7, 1999

A BY-LAW ESTABLISHING MAJOR ROAD NETWORK PERMIT FEES

WHEREAS the Authority may on an application, accompanied by the prescribed fee, issue:

- (a) an overload permit for the operation along any major road forming part of the major road network;
- (b) a crossing permit for the operation across a major road forming part of the major road network;
- (c) an oversize permit for the operation along any road forming part of the major road network.

The Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority enacts as follows:

1. **“Commercial Vehicle”** includes:

- (a) a motor vehicle having permanently attached to it a truck or delivery body;
- (b) an ambulance, casket wagon, fire apparatus, hearse, motor bus, tow car, road building machine, taxi and a tractor,
- (c) a combination of vehicles, and
- (d) other vehicles as specified by regulation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council;

“Major Road Network” has the meaning as defined in the *Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority Act*.

- 2. As authorized by Section 24(6) of the Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority Act, the Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority issue permits under Section 8 of the Commercial Transport Act for the operation of Commercial Vehicles on roads forming part of the Major Road Network.
- 3. This bylaw shall be cited as “Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority Major Road Network Permit Fees, Bylaw Number 7, 1999”.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME this 29th day of March, 1999.
